



## **Professor Mohammad Abu Hilal MD PhD DocEur FRCS FACS ESBQ (HPB)**

Professor Mohammad Abu Hilal is the chair of the Department of Surgery and the Head of Hepatobiliary - Pancreatic and Minimally invasive Surgery at the Poliambulanza Hospital – Brescia – Italy. He is also a Professor of Hepatobiliary Pancreatic Surgery at the University of Southampton.

Professor Abu Hilal has a huge interest in minimally invasive surgical techniques and has been pushing boundaries in MI HPB surgery in the last 2 decades.

Professor Abu Hilal has developed and described several surgical techniques in HPB surgery, which has been published in high impact factor surgical journals.

Prof Abu Hilal has established several technical courses in laparoscopic HPB surgery with more than 50 surgical practical courses, taking place in the last 2 decades with the attendance of more than 400 Surgeons from all over the world. He has been regularly invited to perform surgical demonstration, mentor colleagues in different countries and to perform live link surgery with a more than 50 international meeting.

Professor Abu Hilal's work and reputation has been well recognized world-wide, he has been invited a guest speaker to many international meetings, he has been involved as a proctor and a mentor by many units around the world and had often attracted intense media attention.

He has published more than 300 papers and abstracts and more than 150 oral presentations, in addition to a number of book chapters. And was invited as a guest speaker he gave more than 250 Lectures in national and international meetings.
